# Getting Better Gas Mileage



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## Save money at the gas pump by following these tips:

### Maintenance

- ◆ Check your tire pressure. If your tires are low on air they will wear out faster and you will use more gas. Use the highest psi listed for your tires.
- ◆ Change your oil regularly. Check your owner's manual to find out how often.



- ◆ Keep your engine tuned-up. When your engine runs smoothly, it uses less gas.
- ◆ Replace your air filters regularly.

### Driving

- ◆ Keep your speed steady when you drive.
- ◆ Don't leave your engine idling.
- ◆ Remove extra items from your trunk. The extra weight uses more gas.
- ◆ Drive slower. While you need to keep up with traffic, you don't need to pass it up. The faster you drive the more fuel you use.
- ◆ Use overdrive gears during highway driving.
- ◆ Combine errands.
- ◆ Take off slowly from a stop.



### Gassing Up

- ◆ Buy the lowest octane gasoline listed in your owner's manual.



- ◆ Buy gas early in the morning. When gas warms it expands so you get less gas in your tank.
- ◆ Be cautious for ads for gas-saving products. Check the facts.
